GEUS CONTINUES CLOSURE OF FACILITIES

(April 15, 2020-Greenville, Texas) GEUS has extended closure of its facilities to the public through April 30, 2020.

GEUS implemented its Pandemic Response Plan on March 12, 2020. The plan, which includes strict precautions to reduce the threat of exposure to COVID-19 to customers, employees and visitors to GEUS facilities, was later extended thru April 14, 2020.

“GEUS recognizes this closure has created inconveniences for some customers,” said GEUS General Manager Alicia Price. “I appreciate the ingenuity of GEUS employees to quickly develop new ways to continue to provide services to our consumer/owners,” Price added.
