### **FATALITY AT GEUS SUBSTATION**

(December 12, 2020-Greenville, Texas) GEUS is working with authorities who are investigating a fatality that occurred around 3:30am this morning at the Oneal Street Substation.

The decedent was not a GEUS employee. Our sympathy goes out to the family of this individual. We have no further information to report at this time.

GEUS became the first municipally-owned electric utility in Texas in 1891. 110 years later it became the first municipally-owned cable television and high speed Internet operation in Texas. GEUS offers these services to the 26,000 plus consumerowners living in the Greenville, Texas area located approximately 50 miles East of Dallas, Texas. GEUS is uniquely governed by an autonomous board of trustees that is appointed by the Greenville City Council. Steps were taken by the Texas Legislature in 1989 to allow this type of governing structure.
